Getting Started:

- 1. Turn on Guided Access:
 - Go to Settings > Accessibility > Guided Access.
 - Toggle **Guided Access** on.
 - Set a **Passcode** or enable **Face ID/Touch ID** for exit.



2. Open the App:

• Launch the app you want your child to use (e.g., a game, educational app, etc.).

3. Activate Guided Access:

- Triple-click the **Side button** (iPhone X or later) or the **Home button** (iPhone 8 or earlier).
- Click **Start** in the pop-up.

Customizing the Fence:

Now, your iPhone is locked in that specific app. But you can still adjust the boundaries of the fence:

• **Disable Touch Areas:** Use your finger to circle areas you want to disable, like the notification bar, app menu, or specific buttons within the app. This prevents accidental exits or unwanted actions.
